WeightCheck

Counting made easy: Incorrect entries of quantities are avoided and counting of items is a thing of the past with RetailApp WeightCheck.

The RetailApp WeightCheck uses the core component weight in order to calculate and issue quantities. It supports the selling process with two functions: With the first function, this RetailApp checks if the quantity entered on the scale is correct. The basis is the average weight of a piece item. The RetailApp compares the entered value with the actual value on the load platter. Its second function: It determines the quantity of very light weight items. Based on the average weight of an item the RetailApp calculates how many pieces are placed on the load platter at a minimum. This allows easy and reliable output of the number of screws in hardware stores, for example. Always accurately informed about the quantity on the scale's load platter thanks to WeightCheck.

Functionalities

- Provision of two functions:
 - Check quantity function
 - Display quantity function
- Use of an average weight per piece and tolerance value in percent
- Teach function in order to determine the average weight

- Due to an integrated check function the number of pieces on the label equals the quantity in the bag
